ABOUT CAMP:

All 4 Autism is excited to invite you to Camp Saint John 2017! Our summer camp offers fun and fellowship for children and teens ages 4-18. Campers enjoy various activities, crafts and life lessons that build self-esteem and friendships. This inclusion-based program is designed for both ASD kids and their typically developing peers. Camp Saint John is named after John the Apostle, Patron Saint of Friendship, with the main purpose of providing a summer camp that promotes friendship, inclusion and acceptance.

2. **Meet & Greet:** Upon receipt of registration, all **new campers** are scheduled for a visit to our resource center to determine if we have the resources to meet their needs.
3. **Payment:** The camp registration fee of \$20 will be collected during the Meet & Greet. Please make checks payable to All 4 Autism.

REQUIREMENTS:

Camp Saint John will do everything possible to welcome and accommodate all children, but we do not currently have the resources to provide one-on-one services for self-injurious behaviors, aggressive behaviors, or sexual behaviors that are severe and may put other campers at risk. All new campers will attend an informal meet and greet at our resource center so that we have the opportunity to get to know the families, and see if our camp is a good fit. If we determine we do not have the necessary resources, we will try to provide referrals to other services in our area that can accommodate his or her specific needs.
